Late Summer - Fall Bass Fishing		
Range of Water	Location Bass Can be Found	Common Fall Lures and Tactics
89-79 degrees	Main lake channels bends, points, humps, structure	Deep diving crankbaits, Carolina rigged plastic lures
79-69 degrees	Creek mouths, points, humps, rocks and other structure	Fish isolated wood cover with crankbaits, jigs, spinnerbaits and swim baits and top water
69-59 degrees	Points, hump, channel bends, secondary feeder creeks, vegetation	spinnerbaits, swimbaits, lipless cranks over vegetation, knock wood cover with crankbaits
59-49 degrees	Points, flats in the backs of creeks, vegetation, wood cover	slow roll spinnerbaits and downsized baits near laydowns, solitary wood cover
49 -39 degrees	Wood covers in shallow water at the back of creeks, deep channels and rip rap rocks	Smaller baits crankbaits, jigs, small swimbaits, hair jig beneath a bobber known as the float and fly! Team Bilbrey Fishing

OUTINGS FOR THE 2013/2014 SEASON

Oct. 18th. SATURDAY, on the MISSISSIPPI, CLEMENTS BARGE.

Opportunity for mixed species and easy fishing. I will have a projected fish report at the Sept 10th meeting as well as a sign up sheet for car pooling. Hope to see you there.

Nov. 2ond, a Saturday. Off to Lake Wisconsin with our very own Jim Kloth as our mentor. Jim has fished Lake Wisconsin extensively and will try to put us on the Walleye and Sauger

Dec. No outings, too busy w/ Holiday season.

Jan. YFC Derby on Waubesa and Kids Ice Fishing.

Feb. Whitefish out of Sturgeon Bay again, a weekend trip, probably Dec. 31 – Feb.2nd. I think the Super Bowl will be Feb. 8th?

March – Clements Barge, typically 1st week of them opening about mid March. Weather is often a problem. April – We went to Reelfoot, TN. last April for a week trip to get away from the WI weather. I'm open for suggestions.

May - Green Bay walleye weekend or Whitebass run on the Fox or ???.

For an extended outing, Voyaguer National Park in Northern Minnesota would be similar to a Canadian trip. This could be on a house boat or at a resort. A house boat would need a 10 person minimum to keep the cost reasonable but still more money than a resort. This is a huge wilderness area with 84,000 acres of water. Check out http://www.nps.gov/voya/index.htm and Google for a lot more info.

Another possibility is an Ontario trip at a resort. Jim Pankrantz gave me this tip. "Here's the link to the lodge I was telling you about. http://www.birchdalelodge.com/best-walleyefishing-ontario.htm To compare check this link to Andy Meyer's lodge which is located in the same bay and uses the same guide service, 4 x 4 and fly-ins. http://www.andymyerslodge.com/ Great place but a lot more expensive. They also have a fishing report (Steve Herbeck posts) which can give you an idea about what they are catching when. http://www.outdoors911.com/reports/forumdisplay.php?15-Eagle-Lake

For Birchdale Lodge the rate without food would be \$616.50 for the week including the boat with the 10% group discount and \$485 if you bring your own boat. If people wanted to camp it would be \$225 for the week. They provide a free camp fish fry mid week for dinner which is awesome and they even give you free beer. We may be able to get an even better rate or something like a boat upgrade package instead of a discount. The time frame I gave you was July August which is the best time for overlap of all species. June is a better month for lake trout, smallies, and big northern in the shallower water. Fall smallies and big muskie. Walleyes any time.

They told me that they could set up a video conference on the computer for our club to answer any questions for us any time. If any of this interests you at all I can contact them and see what they could possibly offer us. I know when I spoke to them this summer on my trip that they usually have open spots more so in August and have no problems filling the rest of the summer. We always go the second through third week of July with our kids. Booking May-July can be done but just needs to be reserved further in advance. We have usually booked by Jan/February but others literally book up to a year in advance."


